

# ELEVATING WORK PLATFORM



## ✓ DO

- ✓ The platform will only be operated by an employee with a driving license, insurance, and a valid permit and training for working at heights.
- ✓ The suitability of the aerial platform for the necessary workload must be verified as written in the safety review.
- ✓ Make sure that the lifting surface is free of oils and other substances.
- ✓ The workplace must be fenced and controlled to prevent the entry of passers-by.
- ✓ A safety harness must be worn and fit to the body and connected to the anchor point on the stage.
- ✓ A protective helmet with a chin guard must be worn.
- ✓ Wear safety shoes and use personal protective equipment.
- ✓ Look all the way ahead and make sure that the travel path is stable and clear of obstacles.
- ✓ Keep a distance from overhead power lines, in accordance with the law.
- ✓ Presence of an additional employee must be verified for the purpose of the rescue operations and the activation of the aerial platform, in case of an emergency situation.

## ✗ DON'T

- ✗ Do not operate the platform without a valid work permit for lifting platforms.
- ✗ The lifting platform must not be operated without the approval of a validly qualified inspector.
- ✗ Do not load over the platform's carrying capacity, and do not use it as a substitute for the lifting device.
- ✗ Do not bend over the fences of the work surface.
- ✗ Do not climb or descend from the work platform through the area of the elevating mechanism.
- ✗ Do not lean materials on the fences and do not hang equipment on them.
- ✗ Avoid working with the lifting platform outside when there is a strong wind, lightning and insufficient light.
